A COMPILATION OF PROFITABLE TRAINER ANGLES

# INTRODUCTION

Thanks for choosing to download our newly released compilation of trainer angles for the 2018/19 racing season.

Unlike the majority of betting angles, which involve several rules and a lengthy time commitment, we've opted to focus on specific trainers with proven form over several seasons.

There are two minimum requirements for each of our trainer angles, based on performance over the last five racing seasons:

- 1. It has produced a substantial profit at Betfair Start Price.**
- 2. It has a winning strike rate of 20% or greater.**

Using this as our base, we have identified a total of eight simple but effective angles, which can be used to identify wagers with a high likelihood of returning a substantial future profit.

# ANGLE 1

## Trainer: Kenneth Slack

Perhaps surprisingly, simply following all Slack trained runners over the last five racing seasons has provided a substantial profit, at both industry and Betfair start price:

<b>Qualifiers</b>	<b>228</b>
<b>Win</b>	<b>51</b>
<b>Win %</b>	<b>22.07%</b>
<b>Place</b>	<b>99</b>
<b>Place %</b>	<b>43.42%</b>
<b>SP Profit</b>	<b>68.73 points</b>
<b>SP ROI</b>	<b>30.14%</b>
<b>Betfair SP Profit</b>	<b>111.19 points</b>
<b>BSP ROI</b>	<b>48.77%</b>

Notes: This angle produces a conservative volume of qualifiers, at just shy of fifty per season, but can easily be combined with other angles to increase bet volume and total profit.

# ANGLE 2

**Trainer: Tom Lacey**

**Race Code: National Hunt**

Over the last three national hunt seasons, Lacey trained runners have produced the following results:

<b>Qualifiers</b>	<b>326</b>
<b>Win</b>	<b>72</b>
<b>Win %</b>	<b>22.09%</b>
<b>Place</b>	<b>140</b>
<b>Place %</b>	<b>42.94%</b>
<b>SP Profit</b>	<b>159.64 points</b>
<b>SP ROI</b>	<b>48.97%</b>
<b>Betfair SP Profit</b>	<b>246.7 points</b>
<b>BSP ROI</b>	<b>75.67%</b>

Notes: This angle has produced the greatest Industry SP profit to date, making it a good option for punters who don't use the betting exchange.

# ANGLE 3

**Trainer: Derek Shaw**

**Race Type: Handicap**

Over the last five racing seasons, Mr Shaw has enjoyed an excellent performance in handicap races, as follows:

<b>Qualifiers</b>	<b>554</b>
<b>Win</b>	<b>61</b>
<b>Win %</b>	<b>11.01%</b>
<b>Place</b>	<b>144</b>
<b>Place %</b>	<b>25.99%</b>
<b>SP Profit</b>	<b>64.2 points</b>
<b>SP ROI</b>	<b>11.59%</b>
<b>Betfair SP Profit</b>	<b>277.29 points</b>
<b>BSP ROI</b>	<b>50.05%</b>

Notes: Due to the conservative strike rate, the use of a larger bankroll (250 points) is recommended. There is also the option to go each way at odds of 4/1 and over.

# ANGLE 4

**Trainer: Charlie Appleby**

**Race Type: Non-Handicap**

Going the opposite route to our previous angle, focusing on non-handicaps races with Appleby trained runners has produced the following results:

<b>Qualifiers</b>	<b>647</b>
<b>Win</b>	<b>186</b>
<b>Win %</b>	<b>28.75%</b>
<b>Place</b>	<b>350</b>
<b>Place %</b>	<b>54.1%</b>
<b>SP Profit</b>	<b>32.96 points</b>
<b>SP ROI</b>	<b>5.09%</b>
<b>Betfair SP Profit</b>	<b>103.05 points</b>
<b>BSP ROI</b>	<b>15.93%</b>

Notes: Don't be misled by the appealing place strike rate. The greatest profit levels have been produced betting to win only, even at higher odds.

# ANGLE 5

**Trainer: Charlie Appleby**

**Jockey: William Buick**

Another Appleby based angle; over the last five racing seasons, combining this trainer with jockey William Buick has resulted in substantial profit:

<b>Qualifiers</b>	<b>450</b>
<b>Win</b>	<b>119</b>
<b>Win %</b>	<b>26.44%</b>
<b>Place</b>	<b>227</b>
<b>Place %</b>	<b>50.44%</b>
<b>SP Profit</b>	<b>74.6 points</b>
<b>SP ROI</b>	<b>16.58%</b>
<b>Betfair SP Profit</b>	<b>146.1 points</b>
<b>BSP ROI</b>	<b>32.47%</b>

Notes: This is predominantly a flat racing angle, but there are also a conservative number of qualifiers on the all weather.

# ANGLE 6

## Trainer: W P Mullins

Is Willie Mullins the best trainer in horse racing today?

A question to spark much debate; simply following all runners over the last five racing seasons has resulted in both a generous strike rate, and profit at Betfair SP:

<b>Qualifiers</b>	<b>2205</b>
<b>Win</b>	<b>600</b>
<b>Win %</b>	<b>27.21%</b>
<b>Place</b>	<b>1098</b>
<b>Place %</b>	<b>49.79%</b>
<b>SP Profit</b>	<b>-38.01 points</b>
<b>SP ROI</b>	<b>-1.72%</b>
<b>Betfair SP Profit</b>	<b>267.64 points</b>
<b>BSP ROI</b>	<b>48.77%</b>

Notes: There is a tendency for Mullins trained runners to be over-bet, hence the loss produced at Industry SP. Instead, go with either Betfair SP, or take a mid-morning bookmaker price.



# ANGLE 7

**Trainer: W P Mullins**

**Course: Punchestown**

If we narrow down the full range of Mullins qualifiers by focusing on his (arguably) favourite course, we can establish SP profit and reduce the volume of bets by over 70%:

<b>Qualifiers</b>	<b>343</b>
<b>Win</b>	<b>77</b>
<b>Win %</b>	<b>22.45%</b>
<b>Place</b>	<b>152</b>
<b>Place %</b>	<b>44.31%</b>
<b>SP Profit</b>	<b>40.06 points</b>
<b>SP ROI</b>	<b>11.68%</b>
<b>Betfair SP Profit</b>	<b>120.34 points</b>
<b>BSP ROI</b>	<b>35.19%</b>

Notes: Punchestown is predominantly a National Hunt course, so the majority of qualifiers are produced from late autumn to early spring.

# ANGLE 8

**Trainer: W P Mullins**

**Race Code: Flat**

Once again, we've narrowed down the full range of Mullins runners. An impressive profit has been produced over the last three flat racing seasons:

<b>Qualifiers</b>	<b>165</b>
<b>Win</b>	<b>40</b>
<b>Win %</b>	<b>24.24%</b>
<b>Place</b>	<b>76</b>
<b>Place %</b>	<b>46.06%</b>
<b>SP Profit</b>	<b>68.41 points</b>
<b>SP ROI</b>	<b>41.46%</b>
<b>Betfair SP Profit</b>	<b>115.17 points</b>
<b>BSP ROI</b>	<b>70.23%</b>

Notes: Angles seven an eight are mutually exclusive, so can be used side by side with no crossover of qualifiers.

# CONCLUSION

The consistent use of a single, or combination, of the racing angles laid out in this guide, should prove effective in the pursuit of future betting profit, based on the performance seen so far.

Following all Trainer Treasure angles (angle 6 has been omitted due to the loss at Industry SP) combined, over the past five racing seasons, has produced an impressive overall result.

Investing a £1,000 bankroll, and betting to win only at £10 level stakes, has provided a substantial additional income:

<b>Win</b>	<b>606</b>
<b>Win %</b>	<b>22.34%</b>
<b>SP Profit</b>	<b>£5,086.00</b>
<b>SP Profit per season</b>	<b>£1,017.20</b>
<b>BSP profit</b>	<b>£11,198.40</b>
<b>BSP profit per season</b>	<b>£2,239.68</b>
