A COMPILATION OF PROFITABLE TRAINER ANGLES

INTRODUCTION

Thanks for choosing to download our newly released compilation of trainer angles for the 2018/19 racing season.

Unlike the majority of betting angles, which involve several rules and a lengthy time commitment, we've opted to focus on specific trainers with proven form over several seasons.

There are two minimum requirements for each of our trainer angles, based on performance over the last five racing seasons:

- 1. It has produced a substantial profit at Betfair Start Price.
- 2. It has a winning strike rate of 20% or greater.

Using this as our base, we have identified a total of eight simple but effective angles, which can be used to identify wagers with a high likelihood of returning a substantial future profit.

Trainer: Kenneth Slack

Perhaps surprisingly, simply following all Slack trained runners over the last five racing seasons has provided a substantial profit, at both industry and Betfair start price:

Qualifiers	228
Win	51
Win %	22.07%
Place	99
Place %	43.42%
SP Profit	68.73 points
SP ROI	30.14%
Betfair SP Profit	111.19 points
BSP ROI	48.77%

Notes: This angle produces a conservative volume of qualifiers, at just shy of fifty per season, but can easily be combined with other angles to increase bet volume and total profit.

Trainer: Tom Lacey

Race Code: National Hunt

Over the last three national hunt seasons, Lacey trained runners have produced the following results:

Qualifiers	326
Win	72
Win %	22.09%
Place	140
Place %	42.94%
SP Profit	159.64 points
SP ROI	48.97%
Betfair SP Profit	246.7 points
BSP ROI	75.67%

Notes: This angle has produced the greatest Industry SP profit to date, making it a good option for punters who don't use the betting exchange.

Trainer: Derek Shaw

Race Type: Handicap

Over the last five racing seasons, Mr Shaw has enjoyed an excellent performance in handicap races, as follows:

Qualifiers	554
Win	61
Win %	11.01%
Place	144
Place %	25.99%
SP Profit	64.2 points
SP ROI	11.59%
Betfair SP Profit	277.29 points
BSP ROI	50.05%

Notes: Due to the conservative strike rate, the use of a larger bankroll (250 points) is recommended. There is also the option to go each way at odds of 4/1 and over.

Trainer: Charlie Appleby

Race Type: Non-Handicap

Going the opposite route to our previous angle, focusing on nonhandicaps races with Appleby trained runners has produced the following results:

Qualifiers	647
Win	186
Win %	28.75%
Place	350
Place %	54.1%
SP Profit	32.96 points
SP ROI	5.09%
Betfair SP Profit	103.05 points
BSP ROI	15.93%

Notes: Don't be misled by the appealing place strike rate. The greatest profit levels have been produced betting to win only, even at higher odds.

Trainer: Charlie Appleby

Jockey: William Buick

Another Appleby based angle; over the last five racing seasons, combining this trainer with jockey William Buick has resulted in substantial profit:

Win	119
Win %	26.44%
Place	227
Place %	50.44%
SP Profit	74.6 points
SP ROI	16.58%
Betfair SP Profit	146.1 points
BSP ROI	32.47%

Notes: This is predominantly a flat racing angle, but there are also a conservative number of qualifiers on the all weather.

Trainer: W P Mullins

Is Willie Mullins the best trainer in horse racing today?

A question to spark much debate; simply following all runners over the last five racing seasons has resulted in both a generous strike rate, and profit at Betfair SP:

Qualifiers	2205
Win	600
Win %	27.21%
Place	1098
Place %	49.79%
SP Profit	-38.01 points
SP ROI	-1.72%
Betfair SP Profit	267.64 points
BSP ROI	48.77%

Notes: There is a tendency for Mullins trained runners to be overbet, hence the loss produced at Industry SP. Instead, go with either Betfair SP, or take a mid-morning bookmaker price.

Trainer: W P Mullins

Course: Punchestown

If we narrow down the full range of Mullins qualifiers by focusing on his (arguably) favourite course, we can establish SP profit and reduce the volume of bets by over 70%:

Win	77
Win %	22.45%
Place	152
Place %	44.31%
SP Profit	40.06 points
SP ROI	11.68%
Betfair SP Profit	120.34 points
BSP ROI	35.19%

Notes: Punchestown is predominantly a National Hunt course, so the majority of qualifiers are produced from late autumn to early spring.

Trainer: W P Mullins

Race Code: Flat

Once again, we've narrowed down the full range of Mullins runners. An impressive profit has been produced over the last three flat racing seasons:

Qualifiers	165
Win	40
Win %	24.24%
Place	76
Place %	46.06%
SP Profit	68.41 points
SP ROI	41.46%
Betfair SP Profit	115.17 points
BSP ROI	70.23%

Notes: Angles seven an eight are mutually exclusive, so can be used side by side with no crossover of qualifiers.

CONCLUSION

The consistent use of a single, or combination, of the racing angles laid out in this guide, should prove effective in the pursuit of future betting profit, based on the performance seen so far.

Following all Trainer Treasure angles (angle 6 has been omitted due to the loss at Industry SP) combined, over the past five racing seasons, has produced an impressive overall result.

Investing a £1,000 bankroll, and betting to win only at £10 level stakes, has provided a substantial additional income:
