INTRODUCTION

Thanks for downloading this manual, where we're going to look at three of the top performing trainer angles from the 2016 – 2018 racing seasons.

With proven performance over a three year period, we're likely to see continued success from these angles for the foreseeable future.

Before we delve into the rule-set for each angle, let us briefly discuss our fundamental approach to finding profitable betting angles at *Lucrative Racing*:

Step 1: Logic, Logic, Logic.

We have opted to focus on broadly successful trainers, that also specialise in a specific race type, at specific classes of race, or at specific racetracks.

In addition, trainers often have a season in which they perform most favourably, which we have identified for each of our angles.

Step 2: Is It Proven Profitable?

The past performance for each angle has analysed with a fine tooth comb, to establish both substantial and consistent profit.

Step 3: Don't Guess, Put It To The Test.

Past data is a good indicator of future profit, but it's by no means infallible. At *Lucrative Racing*, we believe in testing each angle live, for a minimum of 6 months.

If the live testing performance is favourable, only then will we consider sharing the angle with our readers.

Step 4: Review, Refine, Research

We regularly review each angle, refine to improve future performance if necessary, and research new angles to test and potentially implement in future.

Currently, we have a total of twelve profitable trainer win angles in our betting portfolio.

Although nine of these angles aren't currently available to the general public, we offer a tipping service to provide each days qualifiers for all twelve trainer angles.

Without further ado, let's delve into our top three trainer angles...

ANGLE 1

Trainer: Peter Bowen

Race Type: Handicap

Season: February - September

Bowen is a specialist in handicap races, and following the above criteria has provided excellent results over the past three years:

Qualifiers	416
Win	82
Win %	19.71%
Place	163
Place %	39.18%
SP Profit	75.06 points
SP ROI	18.04%
Betfair SP Profit	136.6 points
BSP ROI	32.84%

Notes: Betting Season refers to the times of year in which the trainer has historically been in form, and profitable. Trainers are unlikely to be profitable to follow outside their betting season.

ANGLE 2

Trainer: Paul Nicholls

Racetracks: Chepstow, Fontwell & Wincanton

Betting Season: February - November

Nicholls is something of a track specialist, and focusing on the three where he has performed best, has produced both an impressive win rate and profit:

Qualifiers	278
Win	105
Win %	37.77%
Place	148
Place %	53.24%
SP Profit	80.99 points
SP ROI	29.13%
Betfair SP Profit	109.08 points
BSP ROI	39.24%

Notes: Although Nicholls trained horses are typically over-bet, he can still prove very profitable to follow at specific times of year and locations.

ANGLE 3

Trainer: Henry Daly

Race Code: National Hunt

Race Class: 3 - 5

Betting Season: May - December

Daly is a NH specialist, and omitting the ultra-competitive race classes he has performed very favourably in recent years:

Qualifiers	235
Win	46
Win %	19.57%
Place	94
Place %	40%
SP Profit	84.63 points
SP ROI	36.01%
Betfair SP Profit	158.65 points
BSP ROI	67.51%

Notes: Secure early value by placing your bets in the morning with a best odds guaranteed bookmaker. In the majority of cases, this will outperform Betfair SP over the long term.

CONCLUSION

The combined performance for our three Trainer angles have been laid out in the table below:

Qualifiers	929
Win	233
Win %	25.08%
Place	405
Place %	43.6%
SP Profit	240.68 points
SP ROI	25.91%
Betfair SP Profit	404.33 points
BSP ROI	43.52%

We can see from the stats that an annual profit of approx. 135 points has been generated so far, from 310 qualifiers which translates to roughly one bet to place per day.

With a strike rate equating to one winning bet for every four placed, and an estimated maximum losing run of 24 for every 1,000 bets placed, a 100 point bankroll is recommended.
